INGREDIENTS

Wheat middlings, soybean hulls, dehydrated alfalfa meal, corn distillers dried grains with solubles, molasses products, soybean oil, milled flaxseed, calcium carbonate, salt, L-lysine, sodium metabisulfite (a preservative), calcium hydroxide, zinc proteinate, vitamin E supplement, sodium carboxymethylcellulose, rice hulls, manganese proteinate, copper proteinate, Saccharomyces cerevisiae yeast culture, ascorbic acid, hydrolyzed yeast, brewers dried yeast, magnesium oxide, corn cobs, iron proteinate, silicon dioxide, natural flavor, artificial flavor, selenium yeast, calcium pantothenate, mineral oil, niacin supplement, sodium sulfate, thiamine mononitrate, menadione sodium bisulfite complex (source of vitamin K activity), riboflavin supplement, vitamin A supplement, cobalt proteinate, pyridoxine hydrochloride, vitamin B12 supplement, folic acid, vitamin D3 supplement, ethylenediamine dihydroiodide, biotin, saccharin sodium.

WARNING: This product, which contains added copper, should not be fed to sheep or related species that have a low tolerance to copper.

This product has been formulated specifically for horses and is not intended for other species.

Caution: Follow label directions. The addition to feed of higher levels of this premix containing added selenium is not permitted.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

Feed Summit Senior Pellet according to the following chart along with good quality hay (1.0 – 2 lbs/100 lbs of body weight), free choice mineral and fresh, clean water. This is an ideal ration for horses that cannot eat hay/pastures due to poor teeth, age or other health related problems such as horses affected with a dust sensitive condition, such as heaves.

Activity Level	Amount to Feed/Per Day (1000 lb Horse)
Maintenance	5.0 – 7.5 lbs
Performance Light	6.0 – 8.0 lbs
Performance Moderate	7.0 – 9.0 lbs
Performance Heavy	8.0 – 10.0 lbs
Complete Feed – no hay option	14.0 – 16.0 lbs
