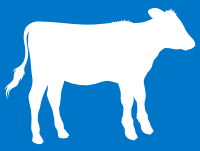

KEEP WARM OPTIONS

- Feed more milk volume
- Feed more energy

COLD WEATHER CALF MANAGEMENT

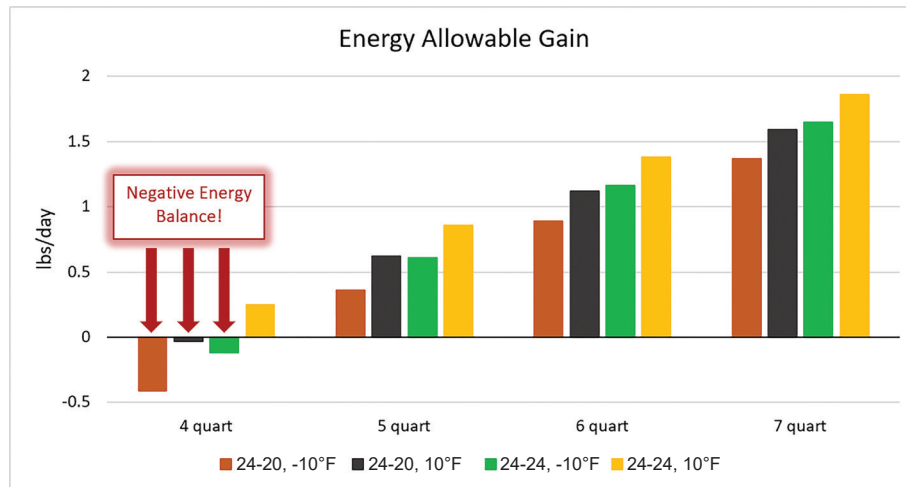
- Dry calves and feed high quality colostrum as soon as possible after birth
- Feed incrementally more milk solution per feeding and initiate a 3rd feeding during severe cold stress season
- Deep bed calves liberally with good quality, dry, long stem straw
- Use calf blankets for the first 4-5 weeks of life
- House calves in a well ventilated, draft free environment with no exposure to older animals
- Wean calves when starter intake is greater than 3 lb per head per day. Age at weaning will vary depending on the amount of milk fed, environmental conditions and weaning protocol. This will normally be at 6-8 weeks of age.



OPTION 1

FEED MORE VOLUME OF MILK SOLUTION TO YOUR CALVES:

- Maximize calf warmth and growth by feeding more volume per day, a minimum of 5-7 quarts per day is recommended
- Provide calves with additional calories by increasing the fat content of the milk solution in conjunction with more volume fed
- Consult with your Hubbard Feeds nutritionist to find out which Hubbard milk replacer will fit your cold weather feeding needs
